

DOMINOES-4

You will surely have played domino on the odd occasion. In this game we display there is a little change in the counters, but the rules are the same:

- ✍ It is a game of **3 players**.
- ✍ After **shuffling the counters**, each player takes 5.
- ✍ It starts the player with the counter:

2	- 3
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- ✍ Each player, in his turn, **puts a counter that 'matches'** with the head or the tail of the **train of counters** that is being formed (double counters are transversally placed).
- ✍ If a player **cannot** place his counter in his turn, **he goes on 'drawing'** counters until he finds a suitable one. If does not find any, **the turn goes to the following player**.
- ✍ The game is over **when none player can place a counter** or **any player can place all his counters**.
- ✍ Each player **scores one point per every counter he has** when the game is over. If a player **places a counter in a wrong position**, the **first player in noticing it -1 point**.

You can **play 4 times**, making previously a record board with the scores of each player. **The winner is the player with the lowest score** after the four plays.

YOU WILL NEED (EACH TEAM):

A game of domino 4 (21 counters) and a sheet to record the score.

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
