

EACH CARD IN ITS PLACE-2

The only difference between this game and the previous one is that the cards here represent other numbers (now they are six consecutive odd numbers, starting from number 3). As it happened in the previous game, the first thing the kids have to do is to place the cards face up, ordered from the lowest to the highest, on the game board (that it is the same one they used before) and pay attention to the place occupied by each card. Then, they will remove them, they will put them face down and after shuffling them, they will place them one by one, in turns, on the board. The scoring system will be the same in case of making a mistake.

The advice provided in the previous case will hold good for this one.

YOU WILL NEED (EACH TEAM):

A set of cards, a board (laminated sheet) to place them and a blank sheet to record the score.

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
